Professional Development

We offer numerous benefits to our staff, including:

Pension Schemes

with defined benefits

Support Staff: most support staff pay less than 7% and the employer pays much more (roughly double) into a secure pension fund.

Teachers: depending on your salary, you will pay in line with the contribution rates for the scheme. The employer pays 23.68% of your salary as our contribution (Reviewed every 4 years).

you can apply for a card which gives 30% off when you buy selected Co-op branded products and 10% off branded products in Co-op Group food stores.

a salary sacrifice arrangement where you agree contractually to a regular reduction from your gross salary to cover the cost of the bike and permitted accessories, therefore making tax and National Insurance savings. This scheme is open 3 times a year for 2 weeks.
